WHAT IS A HARD HAT CAMP?

Through a collaborative effort by the Peninsula Council for Workforce Development, Thomas Nelson Community College, New Horizons Regional Education Centers, Greater Peninsula Career Pathways Consortium and the Associated General Contractors, the Hard Hat Camp is a two-day program for high school counselors exploring education and career opportunities available for students.

Participants will share ideas through open discussions and team-building activities. Local construction industry experts and area educators will present available education programs and jobs available - from labor based to technology focused. Day two consists of an onsite tour of a construction project in progress and a look at the internal operations of a large construction firm.
